

# Court PARKING

**The best long-term parking options for court visitors are the Downtown Garage and the Church Street West parking lot.**

The Downtown Garage costs **\$0.75 per hour**; payment upon exiting. The Church Street West Lot costs **\$1.00 per hour**. Full payment at the Church Street Lot must be paid at one of the multi-space meters when you walk off the Church Street West Lot.

If you don't know how long you're going to be at the court, your best option is to park in the Downtown Garage. You won't have to worry getting a ticket, and you can stay as long as you want. Plus, it's less expensive.

**If you're looking to save even more money, you can park at the Waterfront Garage.** It is only **\$0.25 per hour** and is just a ten-minute walk to the court. The Bridge Street Lot is another low-cost option at \$4.00 per day. However, the lot often fills up early in the morning with commuters using commuter rail.

**For a short stay**, the most convenient option will be to park at a meter on Federal, Church, or Lynde streets. The rate is **\$1.50 per hour**. In addition to taking coins, the meters in these locations accept credit cards.

Please note that on-street parking is enforced by block. That means **you can't feed the meter**. You'll have to move your car to a different block, or you'll run the risk of getting a \$25 ticket.
